Student Requirements

Students require a Year 10 High School Certificate/equivalent.

Students will be required to attend an interview to demonstrate their motivation and interest in completing the full program.

Additional Course Information

If eligible for recognition of prior learning (RPL) you can gain course credits which may result in the reduction of course duration.

Upon completion of this Certificate II in Hospitality you will be able to apply for Certificate III in Hospitality at any VET institution across Australia.

Students may benefit from full State Government funding under the Access Program or partial Federal Government funding under the Federal PPP. Please contact Empyrean's Training Coordinator to assess your eligibility.

Not eligible for Access funding (regardless of Equity Target Group definitions):

1. Students whose primary place of residence is not in Western Australia, including residents of Christmas Island or Cocos Island.
2. Students who are neither Australian citizens nor permanent residents of Australia, unless they are holders of appropriate temporary protection visas, as defined in the Vocational Education and Training (Colleges) Regulations 1996.
3. Secondary school students who do not have an approved Notice of Arrangements. Excludes delivery to students younger than 16 years on 31/12/09.
